

INDOOR CARPET FLOOR MARKERS

Carpet Condition

The surface must be clean prior to the installation process. Standard cleaning methods are appropriate to prepare the carpeted surface. Ensure that the floor is dry before beginning the application.

Application:

1. Peel the backing liner down from the top, fold and crease the paper
2. Using a squeegee, stiff cardboard or soft cloth, apply firm pressure starting from the top. Continue to remove the backing liner and apply equal pressure down the middle and sides of the floor marker
3. Once completed, apply firm strokes from the middle of the marker outwards, to ensure edge adhesion

Maintenance:

1. Do not wax or clean the marker for at least 24 hours after installation
2. Avoid damaging the markers by heavy equipment traffic (tables, forklifts etc.)

Removal:

1. Lift one edge of the marker and pull, using short fast strokes at less than 45 degrees for optimal results.

Caution: Not all low-pile carpets are manufactured identically. Floor markers may not have the same adherence on some low-pile plush carpets as on other commercial grade low-pile carpets. Please test carpeted surfaces prior to final application to ensure a clean adhesive removal.

Optional removability is achieved up to 90 days after installation of the floor marker.
